On the other hand, there are indications that Gruen did retroactively fold existing models into a new category if the model continued to be made into the new classification scheme. Examples being Strap 1, which was M20R in the 1918 catalog, and Quadrons 39 and 40, which started out as Strap 30 and Strap 40.
