That name sure has not aged well. :roll:

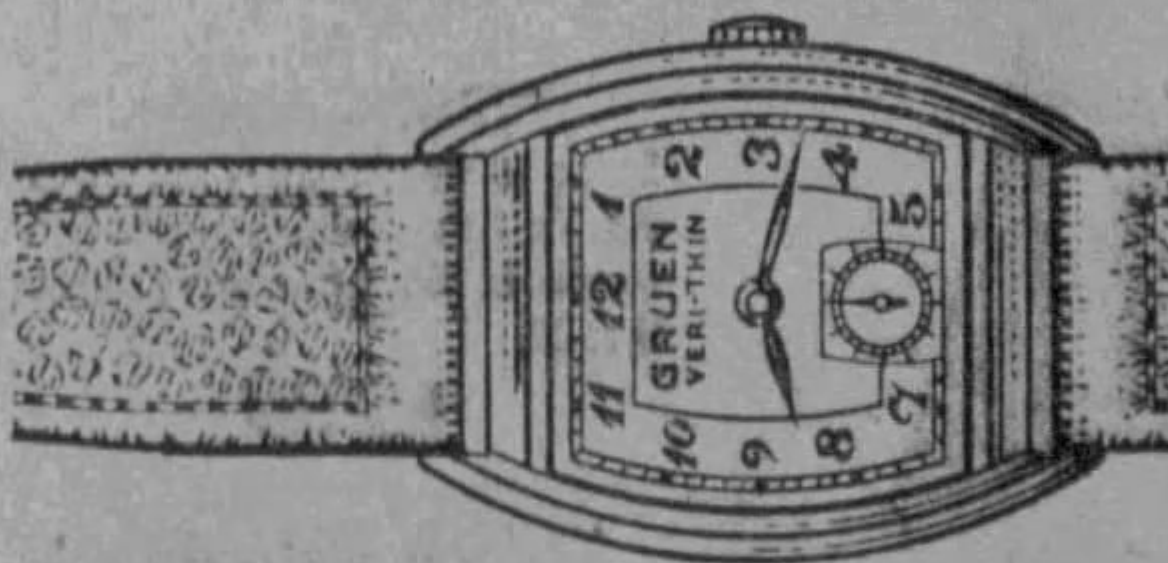
