

NOTICE.

Too much attention has been given to produce a certain Mainspring for a certain price, all of one kind. The result is that the class of watches of which a better and more uniform time is expected have the same mainspring **INSERTED** as the medium and very cheap goods. The manufacturing of a fine mainspring is a **SPECIALTY**, the same as a high class of hairsprings. It requires a special quality of steel and then a **CERTAIN WAY TO WORK** and **SHAPE** it so that the **FRICITION** in coiling and uncoiling will be as little as possible and equalized. Then great care is taken to obtain a **CORRECT TEMPER**, also a correct proportion of the **LENGTH** in accordance to the size of the barrel and barrel arbor is necessary.

In the manufacture of our Precision Watches it was necessary for us to manufacture a special mainspring of our own of the very highest standard. Our many years of manufacturing showed us the requirements, and as our patrons have so often, all over the country asked "why don't you make us your spring for other watches? we are in need of just such a spring." We decided to make them. We wish to assure the public (as we are making them to fit other movements) that they are made after the latest improved methods required for "hand finished" **ADJUSTED MAINSPRINGS** and shall continue to be kept up to that high standard as no other kind **CAN** be considered by us.

A watch with a **GRUEN SPRING** can have a more uniform performance and less breakage of springs; also **REDUCING** the **WEAR** upon the watch owing to them having more life and elasticity proportionate to their thickness.
