

Here's one that I've had for a long time sitting in the drawer with a broken staff. After a little research I got it running using the entire balance from a 329 movement, bridge and all. The 329 balance bridge and balance seems to be identical with the 520 movement. I suspect a lot of other parts are common between these movements.

I was able to get a used working 329 for less than buying just the staff. Swapping the whole balance was a lot easier than re-staffing the 520. I was a little surprised the bridge fit. Usually the alignment pins don't line up on the other movement.



Attached is a photo of both the 520 (top) and 329 (bottom) movements. The 520 has the balance cock and balance from the 329 installed and is running great. The broken staff 520 balance cock and balance are installed in the 329. The upper bridges on the 520 have a cylindrically machined surface to fit the curves case.
